

COVID-19 RESPONSE COLLECTIVE IMPACT FOR NUTRITION - CI4N



The first case of COVID-19 was identified in Bangladesh on 08 March 2020. Due to several socio-cultural and political reasons there was a quick spread of COVID-19 throughout the country since the detection of first case. Consequently, the people of Sunamoni district was also affected. However, the CI4N project has responded in due time supported by the government initiatives. The actions taken by the CI4N project were as follows:

Messaging through National Nutrition Week 2020

Every year Bangladesh government observes the National Nutrition Week on 23rd to -29th of April. This year as it was during COVID-19, so activities were primarily focused on COVID-19. Bangladesh National Nutrition Council (BNNC) developed awareness through public messaging on what is COVID-19, how it is spreading, what are the likely preventive measures, what people should do if infected, how people should live a healthy life by taking nutritious food, and regular physical exercise. Nevertheless, CARE Bangladesh has provided technical support for redesigning these IEC materials and post in BNNC website during NNW.

Advocacy for distribute nutritious food package

Advocacy for establishing hand washing station

To promote hand washing practices among the community, the department of public health engineering-DPHE under the ministry of local government established number of hand washing station in several crowded places at Upazilla (sub-district) level. CI4N has facilitated to identify the appropriate place where the station was established. Citizens are benefitted by this novel initiative.

Promotion of behavior change communication through disseminating appropriate messaging



By demonstrating effective and continuous communication with all the Upazila Nutrition Coordination Committees – UNCC of Sunamganj, the aim of the initiative was to facilitating and generating ideas at the field level e.g. promoting hand washing messages, by using different institutions. The channels are masjid (mosque), temple, educational institutions, restaurant, union Parishad etc. A huge number of message board for said channels were planned under this initiative. The fund were provided by the Islamic foundation, Puja Committee, Secondary Education, LGED and individual donors.
